


HOW TO Form Your Wyoming LLC



01

Choose a Name for Your LLC

Select a unique name that includes "Limited Liability Company," "LLC," or "L.L.C." and ensure it's not already in use by searching the [Wyoming Secretary of State Business Center](#).

02

Appoint a Registered Agent

Designate a registered agent with a physical address in Wyoming to accept legal documents for your LLC; the agent can be an individual or a business entity authorized to operate in the state.

03

File Articles of Organization

Submit the Articles of Organization online or by mail to the Wyoming Secretary of State with your LLC name, registered agent information, and other required details; the filing fee is \$100, and you can file via the [Wyoming Secretary of State website](#).

04

Draft an Operating Agreement (Optional)

While not legally required, drafting an Operating Agreement is highly recommended to outline the management, ownership structure, and operational guidelines of your LLC.

05

Obtain an EIN (Employer Identification Number)

Get an EIN from the IRS for tax purposes, hiring employees, and opening a business bank account by applying for free on the [IRS website](#).

06

Wyoming's Annual Report Requirements

File an annual report with the Wyoming Secretary of State to maintain your LLC's active status; the filing fee is \$60 or more, based on your LLC's assets located in Wyoming.

07

Obtain Necessary Business Licenses and Permits

Depending on your business activities and location, you may need to secure additional state or local licenses or permits. See <https://sos.wyo.gov/business/startabusiness.aspx>
